Our goal is to create an exciting positive experience for each camper through supervised fun and organized daily activities.

Activities are age appropriate, emphasize social and character development, leadership, teamwork, sportsmanship and fun! Our dedicated and well trained staff encourage campers to socialize and make new friends through structured activities for teams and individuals as well as free time.

Camp weeks 1-5 and 7-10 are Mon-Fri, week 6 is Tue-Fri (no camp Mon July 4). Camp activities are scheduled 9am-4pm.

Each camp group has one hour of swim time everyday.

Campers enjoy free play/time when dropped off as early as 7:30am and picked up as late as 5:30pm. There are a variety of options available to accommodate busy parents and campers; full week, flex week, full week mornings and full week afternoons! For an additional fee, campers can join us on Thursdays for an adventure or enroll in M/W or T/Th group swim lessons or Wed camp swim team .

Join us May 30– August 5 for these action packed days! Registration and/or changes are required by 4pm the Thu prior to the camp week camper will attend. There is a \$20 fee for registrations or changes received after Thu at 4pm

About FAC Summer Day Camps

Campers ages 4-12 can look forward to days full of creative and fun activities, games and sports to develop healthy and active life-styles. Campers will spend their days at FAC East, swimming daily, participating in activities and games in the various locations around the club, and weather permitting, hiking on nearby trail systems and playing at the park.

Camp Counselors - Your campers are in great hands at FAC Summer Day Camps. All of our counselors are CPR/AED certified, have First Aid training, have completed camp training and know how to work effectively and safely with your campers. Their energy and excitement are sure to impress!

Swimming - Campers participate in age-appropriate swim activities and free swim time with counselors every day. *If your child requires a life jacket please notify camp staff and include an appropriate sized coast guard approved PFD with their camp gear.*

Swim Lessons and Camp Swim Team - Campers can be enrolled in a group swim lesson for an additional fee that is payable with your weeks camp fee. The group lessons are available either M/W or T/Th (Level 1 and Level 2) and Swim Team is every Wed. Counselors and aquatic staff will get them to and from their lesson.

Adventures - Adventures are optional and are an additional fee that is payable with your weeks camp fee. Adventures are always on Thursdays. Week 4 adventure to Lake Mary is for Sharks and Wildcats only. Week 5 adventure to Flagstaff Extreme is for Coyotes, Sharks and Wildcats and is priced differently than other adventures. Adventures will only happen if we can secure transportation and the facilities can accommodate our campers and staff.

Pizza Wednesday - We order pizza every Wednesday. This is optional for your child and a separate fee from camp. Order and cash payment must be received by 9am Wed.

What to bring and what to leave at home

Campers must bring a lunch, at least two snacks, water bottle, swimsuit, towel, sunscreen, and wear comfortable clothing and closed toed shoes. Please label all of your campers belongings. We recommend two separate bags/packs; one for lunch/snacks and one for all other items. Campers must leave all electronics (including phone/smart watch), games, toys, valuables and any personal items not needed for camp at home.

Pre-registration or changes to current registration is required by 4pm Thursday prior to the camp week camper will attend. After deadline if space is available, there is a \$20 fee for late registrations/changes
